A Luminant is a cross between a ruminant and a luminaire. The pelt is made from felted New Zealand merino yarn and the ends are poplar ply.

Luminant creates a nice soft light for reading or relaxing, and is a good choice for a bedside lamp. Luminants are also happy standing on a table, or grazing on the floor.

Luminant comes in a boxed kitset.

Halo | 2007



Halo is a one-off experimental wall light. In 2007 it was included a group exhibition at Objectspace, **Show Room**, curated by Rigel Sorzano and Katy Wallace.

Bud | 2003



Bud is a limited edition fibreglass table light.

Chopping block is a one-off experimental table for food preparation. It is created from 100% waste wood.
